We also celebrated the second year of our partnership with Colorado Gives Day and the Corporate Giving Challenge. We saw a 50% increase from last year in contributions from the Colorado business community totaling \$538,053.

Through the Delta Dental of Colorado Foundation, we did more for 87,000 Coloradans across three key initiatives to improve access to oral health care, prevention, and expansion of the oral health workforce.
